The Role of Faculty Representatives

What You Need to Know Before Elections

Responsibilities

Faculty Representatives on Council shall be responsible to the association for the following:

- a. Governing the business and affairs of AUGSA on behalf of the membership;
- b. Attending and participating in monthly meetings of Council;
- c. Liaison with students and represent their concerns at Council, the University, and/or government.
- d. Responding to AUGSA-related correspondence within 3 business days;
- e. Actively soliciting feedback and opinions from their constituency; and

Graduate Students should be prepared to spend at least 10-15 hours per month dedicated to all responsibilities. Council's primary focus is student representation and advocacy. Serving as a Faculty Representative is a fun and rewarding experience, a great way to give back to the university community, and an excellent opportunity to gain new skills. All Faculty Representatives are compensated an honoraria of \$12,000 for a one-year term of service from May 1 to April 30.
